With this in mind, once a fortnight at 3pm staff in Apples, Palms and Maples room will run separate Zoom sessions catered specifically for the children in that age range. All times and dates will be posted on Telegram shortly along with the ID number and password.

Termly Theme

This term's theme is 'Friends of the earth', Mapledene's children will learn about the planet and how to preserve it. Activities will focus on recycling, reusing items for other purposes and having a better understanding of how our actions may harm the earth. During the 'Lockdown' period, you can help your children with this theme at home. Please also take pictures of your child during this activity and email it to your child's key worker, who will happily include them in your child's learning journey.

Activity Packs

Activity packs are available for your children. The pack includes work samples that are tailored specifically for your child's learning. Staff have been checking up on how things are going, also offering advice on how to support your child's learning while at home. Staff at Mapledene have been busy putting together educational work pack that your children can do at home. Parents can collect their child's work pack from the front entrance. We kindly ask that you do not come into the main building. Your child's keyworker will contact you when your individual packs are ready for collection. Inside each pack you will find a 'Magic Moment' slip, please complete this and email it to your child's keyworker. We would also appreciate it if you would also email pictures and completed work samples to your keyworker. Staff will use this and add them to your child's learning journey book. If you have other pictures of your child's significant learning while on Lockdown please email them too. We are here to help you and your family get through this crisis. If you are claiming benefits and qualify for free vitamins please contact the centre. If you need food parcels for your family or learning resource packs or anything else please get in contact with us. We wish you all well and remind you all to stay within the Government Guidelines to help stop the spread of the Coronavirus. 🌈
